Must I Be In The Church?

Christ saves the lost (Luke 19:10). But is the church *essential to our salvation*? Many feel the church is good but not essential. If one is speaking of membership in church which men have founded, he is right; you need not be a member of any of them. In fact, membership in such religious groups will jeopardize one's hope of heaven. Jesus said speaking of such religious bodies, "Every planting which my heavenly Father hath not planted shall be rooted up (Matthew 15:13). If one contemplates the church Jesus established (Matthew 16:18), he will get a different answer.

You cannot be saved outside of Christ's one true church! The Lord adds the saved to the church (Acts 2:47). Christ is savior of the body (Ephesians 5:23), which is the church (Ephesians 1:22). Jesus purchased the church with His blood (Acts 20:28). If one can be saved without the church, he can be saved without the blood of Christ.

Saul persecuted the church (I Corinthians 15:9). Jesus said to him, "Saul, why persecuted thou me?" (Acts 9:4). The church is so related to Christ that to harm it is to hurt Him.

"Salvation is in Christ" (II Timothy 2:10). But one is baptized into Christ" (Galatians 3:27). Baptism also puts one into the one body or church (I Corinthians 12:13). Therefore, when one is baptized into Christ, he is saved and added to the church.

The church is not a building, institution or organization in the usual meaning of those words. The church is God's saved people. The word "church" is a translation of the Greek word, *ekklesia*. It means "a called out people." It's New Testament meaning is, Christians are called out of life of sin into a life of fellowship with Christ. Those who are not members of the called out church are not among the saved! Are you a member of that one true church you can read of in your Bible?
